**MCOG Meets in Hopland October 5**

Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) will hold its next regular meeting on Monday, October 5 at 1:00 p.m. Usually held in Ukiah, MCOG will meet “on location” in the Bliss Room Banquet Hall at Brutocao School House Plaza, 13500 S. Highway 101 in Hopland. All MCOG meetings are open to the public.

The Council will hear a presentation on transportation plans and projects in the Hopland area. These presentations will include a draft report for the Hopland Main Street Corridor Engineered Feasibility Study, a visit to the County Department of Transportation bridge project across Feliz Creek, a chip seal project on Old River Road in Old Hopland, and a visit to the first roundabout constructed by Caltrans in Mendocino County at Old River Road/SR 175.

Between 10:20 and 10:30 a.m., MCOG council members will gather at Brutocao School House Plaza for a tour from 10:30 to noon. The bus tour will take place in both “Old Hopland” and “New Hopland.” After the bus tour, members will walk around “New Hopland” along Highway 101 to discuss proposed ideas for pedestrian safety, traffic calming measures, potential locations for medians, bike lanes, and reconstructed sidewalks. Members of the public are welcome to join the walk and to ride along on a space-available basis.
