Vision Mendocino 2030 is a regional Blueprint Plan being developed by the Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) to guide sustainable change in Mendocino County over the next 20 years. Mendocino County's plan will be a community-driven, long-range vision document that integrates planning for housing, jobs, transportation, and the environment in Mendocino County.
