MCOG Meets in Laytonville October 1

Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) will hold its next regular meeting on Monday, October 1 at 1:30 p.m. Usually held in Ukiah, MCOG will meet “on location” at the Laytonville Fire Department, 44950 Willis Avenue in Laytonville. The public is welcome at all MCOG meetings.

The Council will hear a presentation by the Local Government Commission on a local project called “Traffic Calming & Downtown Revitalization: Planning for a Livable Community.” This project involving the Laytonville community is sponsored by MCOG and funded by a Caltrans Community Based Transportation Planning grant.

At 12:45 p.m., there will be a “walking tour” of the downtown planning area, starting from the Fire Department at the corner of Willis Avenue and Branscomb Road.

Acting as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency, MCOG programs or allocates various types of state and federal transportation funds to Caltrans, the County of Mendocino and the four incorporated Cities of Ukiah, Fort Bragg, Willits, and Point Arena. In addition to projects on state highways and within its five member jurisdictions, MCOG helps support transportation activities of the Mendocino Transit Authority, North Coast Rail Authority, local airports, and others. Projects involve planning, capital improvements, rehabilitation and maintenance, fleet replacement, and intermodal transit centers.
