MCOG Meets in Fort Bragg October 6

Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) will hold its next regular meeting on Monday, October 6 at 1:30 p.m. Usually held in Ukiah, MCOG will meet “on location” at Town Hall, 363 North Main Street in Fort Bragg. All MCOG meetings are open to the public.

The Council will hear a presentation by Dan Gjerde, City of Fort Bragg’s MCOG representative, on local transportation projects, including recent bicycle, pedestrian, streetscape, and pavement improvements partially funded by MCOG.

At 11:30 a.m., MCOG council members will take a tour of the project area on a bus provided by Mendocino Transit Authority.

Acting as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency, MCOG programs or allocates various types of state and federal transportation funds to Caltrans, the County of Mendocino and the four incorporated Cities of Ukiah, Fort Bragg, Willits, and Point Arena. In addition to projects on state highways and within its five member jurisdictions, MCOG helps support transportation activities of the Mendocino Transit Authority, North Coast Rail Authority, local airports, and others. Projects involve planning, capital improvements, rehabilitation and maintenance, fleet replacement, and intermodal transit centers.
